Special features	<p>The project brief was for the application of a light, strong cover to meet structural requirements in a (then) open ground with occasional gusts from taxiing planes while maintaining the post-modern design language inspired by the grandeur of a plane on the runway. The project redefined the design, class and taste of warehouse-attached offices at the time.</p> <p>The Architects were happy to embrace the offer of a 15-year warranty PVDF paint that MRM was introducing for the first time in Kenya.</p> <p>The project is a past winner of Architectural awards in Cargo Architecture</p>

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

Over 15 years after completion, the PVDF paint coating has held its own very well even on an inferior Galvanized Steel base which does exhibit some signs of corrosion especially at cutting edges along dormer valleys & the paint-on-MS Steel guttering. The rust has unfortunately stained the paint in parts but the overall composition is still quite handsome.
