ADDITIONAL NOTES:

The Developer & his Architect sought the perfect marriage of a functional roof cover with a bold form expression of the classical roman-clay tile that dotted many 'castles' introduced by the early colonial settlers in Kenya to communicate stateliness into the facility. Some of the functional demands included:-

Flexibility – extra-long steel roof tile to cover the slope in single runs.
Engineering – a light, strong material to minimize weight & therefore carrying structure requirement beneath; allowing for a double volume of space within with minimal roof-structure horizontal cross-members.
